

Real Prayer

Dear readers,

the Bible declare that the steps of the righteous are led From from the everlasting God, and step by step, I am happy to share with you the topic that I have always been most at heart in all the years of my ministry: Prayer.

Prayer is: to enter the presence of the Lord.

Prayer is a time spent wholly and exclusively in communion with God

Prayer is not just a time when we speak, ask or say, prayer is primarily a time when we hear what our God wants us.

The word communion means of exchange, sharing and communication.

If we just talk in our time of prayer, we are limiting our communion with God

Let me give an example to clarify this statement.

If we are married and we have always one-way conversations with our spouse, that is, we are always talking about us all the time, we express our needs, our needs, our projects, and we do not ever stop listening to what our beloved or our loved one has to say, surely we are not taking communion, sharing or trading, or if we have children, and we always say how we are to include, what to do, people who can or can not attend, without ever stop listening to what they have to say, we're not having a true communion with them, and much less sharing or exchange.

The real prayer and then, true communion with God, only when we learn not only to speak, but much more when we learn to remain silent before Him

Psalm 37; 7 Be silent before the Lord and wait [...].

Thus, the true moments of intimacy with their loved ones do not have when we speak or communicate something, the most beautiful and unforgettable moments are those where the words become superfluous, not needed. The moments of communion is more important where a glance, a smile or a kind gesture will fill your heart with joy and love, so it is with God

When Jesus taught us to pray to his disciples wanted to communicate this sense of belonging and communion true, especially when he said: "Our Father who art in heaven. Before that time, nobody had dared to invoke God with a word so intimate: Our Father, then God is our father. A good father knows to communicate with their children, knows how to teach and warn, but also knows to listen to their children. God as father certainly want to listen to our demands, but much more, what we want more than anything else, you spend time in true communion with us. A time that is not necessarily known, but a time of intimacy, at times, even without the use of words.

Luke 21; 36 Watch therefore, praying at all times [...].

The writing is very clear on the importance of prayer, and thus a true communion with the Lord, for every child of God if we observe closely the life of our Lord and Master Jesus Christ, we see that even for him the true communion and sharing with his father was a priority.

Luke 6, 12 Or was that in those days he went to the mountain to pray, and spent the night in prayer.

The second prayer is writing one of the highest privilege that has a child of God:

Does not depend on the role you held in the church

Does not depend on the experience that each one may or may not have

It can not be obstructed and denied by no one, not even by the devil himself

Can I say this because the text says that we all have the right to: freedom to enter the sanctuary, under the blood of Jesus, who is the living and recently he has opened for us [...] Hebrews 10 19.

There is nothing more powerful in the whole blood of Jesus Christ the son of God and the devil knows that, knows the sin, the prince and the mayor knows that. We have access to the sanctuary of God, in his presence by means of that precious blood, nothing and nobody can ever stop to pray. If only as children of God know the power of prayer.

Prayer is not a burden; prayer frees us from the weights.

Prayer does not change God, he is already good, prayer changes us.

When we spend time in prayer our hearts are lightened, evacuated our mind, our spirit made ready.

There is a new and fresh anointing to his presence, there is renewal and revelation to those who stay.

I hope that step by step, with these few lines, you can discover in a deeper dimension, the real prayer.
